

**TURN BY TURN - (15) Sunrise 2 to (16) Lake Cuyamaca
Mile 91.5 to 100.5**

Trail Names, Turns, or Key Points on this leg

0	Depart Sunrise Aid Station 2 from the northwest end of the Sunrise parking lot by taking the La Cima Trail.
1.1	Cross Upper Green Valley Road (asphalt) and continue on trail on opposite side of road.
1.12	Turn sharply to the right to continue on the La Cima Trail heading north east. Do not take the La Cima Trail that stays straight and then turns left at this key intersection.
2.56	Turn left onto the California Riding and Hiking Trail (CRHT). This is located on opposite side of Sunrise Hwy where Pedro Fages Monument is located.
4.87	CRHT will intersect the Soapstone Grade Fire Road. Turn right on this dirt road and follow it as it meanders back and forth.
5.78	At this intersection with the Stonewall Creek Fire Road, turn right and continue to follow Soapstone Grade Fire Road. Do not take Stonewall Creek Fire Rd to left!
6.78	Soapstone Grade Fire Road comes to an asphalt road. Turn right on this road and follow it for a short .3 miles where you will turn left onto the Marty Minshall Trail.
6.81	Turn left off of the asphalt road onto the single track Marty Minshall Trail.
7.1	Cross asphalt road and continue straight on Marty Minshall Trail. Stay on Marty Minshall Trail and do not take any side trails like Stonewall Mine Trail.
7.77	Marty Minshall Trail comes to some horse stalls and a dirt road. Take a sharp right at this intersection. If you stay straight you will continue on an extension of the Marty Minshall Trail and this is the wrong direction.
8.1	You will come to a gate that leads to the Lake Cuyamaca bridge. Turn right and pass through the gate and then take an immediate left on a dirt road which will wrap around the east side of the Lake.
8.1+	Turn left and follow dirt road.
8.4	The dirt road slowly becomes a meadow trail that slowly sweeps to the right.

Stay on this grassy trail.

8.57 The meadow trail bends right at the small wooden bridge. Continue to wrap around the Lake in a clockwise direction.

9 The meadow trail will climb slightly up to the Lake Cuyamaca south parking which is the finish line!
